**ORDER AUTHORIZING
CLAIMS ADMINISTRATOR TO
PROVIDE NOTICE TO NEW
HAMPSHIRE CLASS MEMBERS,
EXTENDING DEADLINES FOR NEW
HAMPSHIRE CLASS MEMBERS, AND
RESCHEDULING THE FAIRNESS
HEARING**

WHEREAS, the Claims Administrator has provided notice to registered owners and lessees of class vehicles in 49 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico in accordance with the Court's Preliminary Approval Order, but was unable to provide notice to registered owners and lessees of class vehicles in the State of New Hampshire ("New Hampshire class members") because the required data was not provided by the New Hampshire Department of Motor Vehicles until on or about October 16, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the parties propose to provide the same period for New Hampshire class members to file objections or requests for exclusion; and

WHEREAS, in light of the supplemental notice that will be provided to the New Hampshire class ("Supplemental New Hampshire Notice"), the Court has adjourned the Final Approval hearing date to 11:00 a.m. on **December 12, 2018**; and

WHEREAS, class members from outside the State of New Hampshire that have filed timely objections may presently intend to attend the Final Approval hearing;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Claims Administrator shall issue notice consistent with the forms provided in connection with the Motion for Preliminary Approval that were approved by this Court to the New Hampshire class members within three days of the entry of this Order.

2. Any New Hampshire class member wishing to object to the Settlement or be heard at the Final Approval hearing must:

(a) file a written objection with the **Clerk of the Court**, and must also serve a copy of the objection upon the following, postmarked no later than 30 days after notice:

(b) Any objecting New Hampshire class member must include with his or her objection the information required by the original Notice for objections, which original Notice, shall also be included in the packet sent to the New Hampshire class members with the Supplemental New Hampshire Notice.

3. Any New Hampshire class member wishing to exclude themselves from the Settlement must submit a written request for exclusion to the Claims Administration in the manner as provided for in the Supplemental New Hampshire Notice and the original Notice (which shall be included in the packet sent to New Hampshire class members with the Supplemental New Hampshire Notice), which request for exclusion shall be postmarked no later than 30 days after notice.


4. The Claims Administrator shall update the date for the Final Approval hearing on the

settlement website within 24 hours of entry of this Order with bold font and on the initial homepage, the important dates sidebar of the webpage, and within the FAQs.

5. The Claims Administrator shall send a copy of this Order to each non-New Hampshire objector so that each is aware that the Final Approval hearing date has been adjourned from November 19 to December 12.

6. The Claims Administrator shall file a Declaration before the Final Approval hearing affirming that the Supplemental New Hampshire Notices have been sent as provided herein, that the dedicated settlement website was updated in accordance with this Order, and that the objectors received written notice of the adjournment of the Final Approval hearing date.
